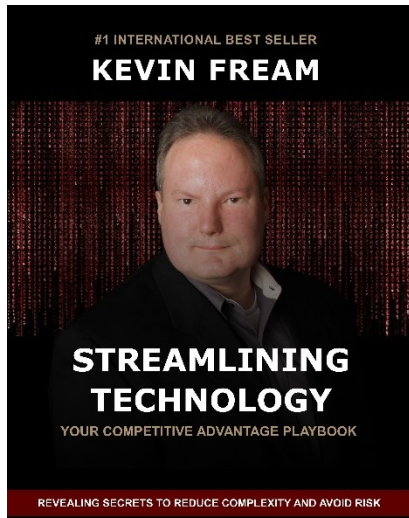


Kevin Fream Bio
